## **Report of the Chair:**

Parallel to the changes and incidents of 2012, several phenomenon and changes happened in Kurdistan region as well. Changes in Government system and ruling, organizational works and political situation in Iraq and Kurdistan all together affected the organizational rate of work directly and indirectly.

Due to the fact that till now the civil organizational works were not taken seriously by the government, rich charitable individuals and internal organizations, depending on a regular law, NGOs works were a great challenge.

Despite various obstacles and short comings, the Foundation was able to implement 32 projects in the fields of health, education and civil resources which consisted of opening awareness and training courses, sponsoring students, publishing brochures and leaflets, providing gifts, granting students, supporting women and introducing them to their rights, empowering youth, rights of students and teachers as well as the rights of patients and physicians. The Foundation also continued to sponsor 146 students to study BA at Cihan University in all academic fields.

Among the significant projects of the Foundation, opening PAR hospital in Erbil is the most sparkling one. It is one of the brilliant projects ever done in Kurdistan region. The Hospital is a great achievement to Iraqi and Kurdish people which includes 118 beds having cardiac, brain, kidney, child delivery, fracture and surgery sections equivalent to modern European health system. Treatment in this hospital is free of charge for poor, martyred and anfal families.

It is worth mentioning that financial source of our Foundation comes from several groups, donors and independent institutions as well as investing companies.

I thank them for their kind cooperation. Finally, I would like to thank the coordinator, staff and the volunteers of our Foundation for what they did in 2012.

Making projects for children and supporting their families, training courses for women, sewing courses, and empowering youths were our foremost concerns in 2012.

The projects in 2012 covered various areas of Kurdistan depending on their need and demands. Those areas were Erbil, Kirkuk, Sulaimani, Garmian, Chamchamal, Kelar, Kfre, Darbandikhan, Duz khurmatu, Rania and Koya.

Fund raising is one of the main concerns in Kurdistan region because those international donors who supported the local sides were decreased in number or almost died out, thus those NGOs who are working in the fields of health and education will face financial difficulties, subsequently they need to seek other fund sources such as companies and faithful individual donors to support their projects. Rebaz Foundation was able to provide fund from that source.

We were happy to make several inordinate and wide relations with local and international sectors, NGOs and SCOs, which will lead to more achievements in future.

2012 was a fertile year for our staff as they attended and participated in trainings inside the country and abroad. The staffs of the Foundation were officially invited to attend up to 15 training courses in Kurdistan, Sweden, Britain and Egypt in the fields of Women, fund raising, human rights, equality and Justice. Finally, I would like to thank the Chair, board of trustees, manager, staff and the volunteers of the Foundation while I wish we could be able to achieve more in 2013.
