## **Report of the Chairman of the Board:**

Even though the political Circumstance of the region, especially in Iraq is going through unexpected twists toward inferior situation, the appearance of ISIS terrorist group and that obstacle manifested in the political and military development has a noticeable effect on the social arena of Iraqi and Kurdish community in particular.

These political episodes lead to a standstill of government institutions activities, and the nongovernmental organizations had their fair share of this, the dilemma of cutting off the budget of the Kurdistan Regional Government of the central government had an extensive impact on the reign's governmental establishment and people's livelihood.

The amount of funds that was provided by none governmental organization directorate to help none governmental organization on the bases of proposing projects, was cut, and this has a tremendous negative effect on the activities of NGOs, most of their projects were canceled, some could not stay active anymore.

Despite of all these difficulties Rebaz Foundation not only was able to continue its ongoing projects, but was able to implement 49 more projects during 2014 in comparison to previous years various projects were prepared emphasizing on Refugees and IDPs, including the distribution of 50 tons of different household necessities were collected in the United Kingdom and that was delivered to the refugees of Kobani, Shengal, and other refugee camps, also this year we were able to implement few different projects in areas of Kurdistan and Iraq.

With the expansion of international and local relationships, government, social, or organization was able to improve these communications, resulting in more than few seminars, and conferences, on the part of funding we thank Cihan Group and other donors for their generosity.

A special thank to PAR Hospital, our staff and the working body of Rebaz Foundation, I also thank the volunteers, management, and the board members. I thank also all our supporters in every city and townships. With my best wishes for more success

Regarding the activities of organizational work, despite of all the obstacles and barriers caused by the current political situation of Kurdistan and Iraq, and the budget shortage of organizations which previously was provided by Directorate of NGOs, Rebaz foundation was able to implement 49 remarkable projects. Doing these projects needed a lot of effort covering Zakho to Khanaqeen in which thousands of children, women, youth and refugees where benefited.

Concerning the IDPs and refugees of Kobani, Mousil, Shingal and other areas, Rebaz foundation was able to do outstanding projects in Erbil, Zakho and Sulaimaniyah.

In 2014 two of Rebaz employees resigned; Zhiyan Ezzat (01/07/2013 – 01/03/2014), and Sarah Ahmed (01/07/2014 – 01/11/2014). We appreciate their effort as they worked like a team with Rebaz staff. Also two new staff replaced their positions; Tara Ali and Avan Abdulrahman on 01/12/2014.

The foundation received financial support from several charitable entities, such as Cihan Group, PAR hospital and in addition to few other donors.

Unfortunately, due to the financial crises in 2014, we were unable to obtain any sorts of fund from the directorate of KRG NGOs, while being able to continue our activities successfully.

In 2014, staff, manager and volunteers of the foundation were able to attend many seminars, activities and workshops arranged on organizational, humanitarian, and scientific issues.

What remains to be said is that we plan to do more in 2015 for better serving the fields of health, education and civic resources. Hereby, I would like to thank the chairman, board members, staff, volunteers and the manager of the foundation and hope them all of success.
