Report of the Chairman of the Board:

The recent ongoing battle between our region and ISIS, a devastating conflict, has led for sure to other diverse and simultaneous crises from the KRG's problematic relation to Iraqi Central Government, economic and local political crises, to the fall back of the governing protocols and so on. The crises have not been undermined if not worsened, and no doubt these crises affected the activities of the governmental and non-governmental institutions. Concerning the international organizations, Rebaz Foundation made effort to cooperate with some international organizations but their support has declined compared to the previous years and their focus is now concentrated on some particular fields and in specific, aiding the Syrian refugees and IDPs. Despite the lack of support and all the crises facing the region that we are not exception from, Rebaz Foundation was still able to take its opportunity and maintain its activities and projects in promoting health, education, and civic resources. Regarding health sector, taking advantage of PAR hospital services, we were able to provide free medical operations and treatments for martyred families and low income students.

We found it necessary to aid students and support educational institutions and schools as well as empowering women and youth by opening courses and workshops.

We hope that in 2016 we overcome the crises and implement more projects to serve our community in this hardship. Our plan for the coming year is that we implement more projects that fit in the special circumstances of the community by researching and planning strategically for our next moves.

Also I would like to thank all the donors, volunteers, our staff and officers. I wish you the best.

kGeneral Coordinator's Report:

In 2015, Rebaz Foundation had several activities, organizational exertions and administrative changes. After relocating our office many times for several years, this year with the kind cooperation and generosity of the cofounder of Miran Group (Mr. Haji Ahmed Haji Ali), we were provided with a proper office in City Center in Sulaimani.

During the year 2015, we were able to implement 22 different and valuable projects in Erbil, Sulaimani and other districts, towns and townships of Kurdistan. In general, we focused on awareness, educational supplementation, health and humanitarian projects.

In accordance with the hard circumstances that the country and the region have undergone so far, especially the late financial crises which the government faces, the number of projects reduced. However, we were capable of continuing our activities. We tried to get funds for our projects from international entities, but unluckily these efforts were fruitless. These days the international sides deducted their wide support to local entities and NGOs. They mostly concentrate on basic needs of Refugees/IDPs in the country as well as some crucial cases such as violence.

From the other side, the financial support from the department of NGOs /KRG almost died out. It is about two years that they were unable to support any projects raised by local NGOs in Kurdistan region due to the mentioned crises existing in the region.

Finally, I would like to thank all the charity entities and individuals who supported our projects so far while I appreciate the hard work of the Chairman, board members and all the brave staff of the Foundation for what they have done to support the foundation to stay on the path of triumph.
